

**Financial Aid Policy for Illinois Attorneys Seeking to Purchase “Deposition  
Testimony: 5 Simple Rules”**

1. Attorneys admitted in Illinois may apply for financial aid by submitting a request to [cle@newmedialegal.com](mailto:cle@newmedialegal.com). Each such request shall include the attorney’s name, home and/or office address, contact telephone number, e-mail address, year of admission, current employer and annual gross income.

2. Financial aid will be awarded based on employment status and/or annual gross income as follows:

<b>Unemployed</b>	<b>90% Discount</b>
<b>Annual Gross Income up to \$35,000</b>	<b>75% Discount</b>
<b>Annual Gross Income up to \$50,000</b>	<b>50% Discount</b>
<b>Annual Gross Income over \$50,000</b>	<b>No Discount</b>

For example, a Illinois attorney who is currently employed with an annual gross income of \$35,000 or less is eligible to receive a 75% discount off the purchase of a license for the video program.

3. Attorneys admitted in Illinois who are engaged in public service are eligible to receive a 50% discount irrespective of their annual gross income. Interested public service attorneys should submit an application for financial aid as described above.
